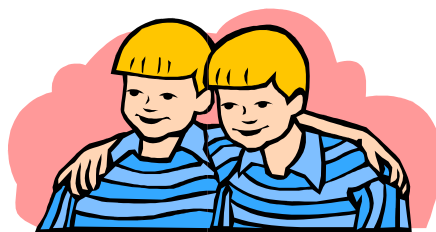


# Do One or Both of your Twins Have Difficulty with Attention?

All children sometimes have problems with attention. For some, these can be bad enough to interfere with life at school and at home.
